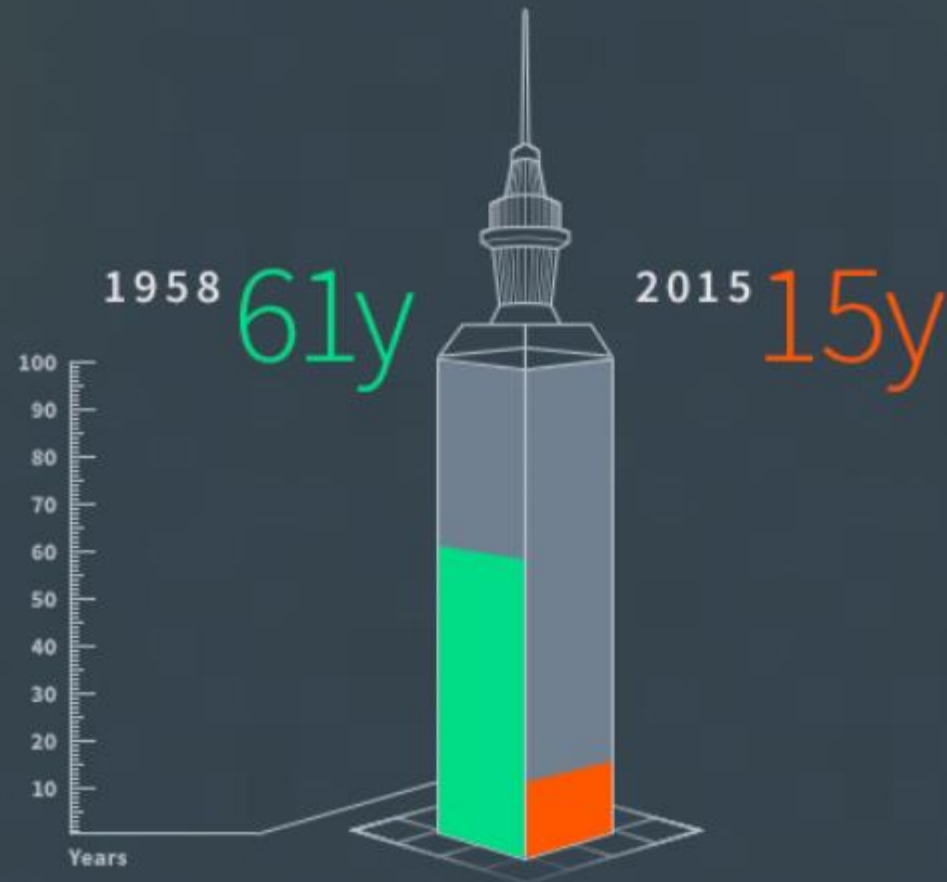

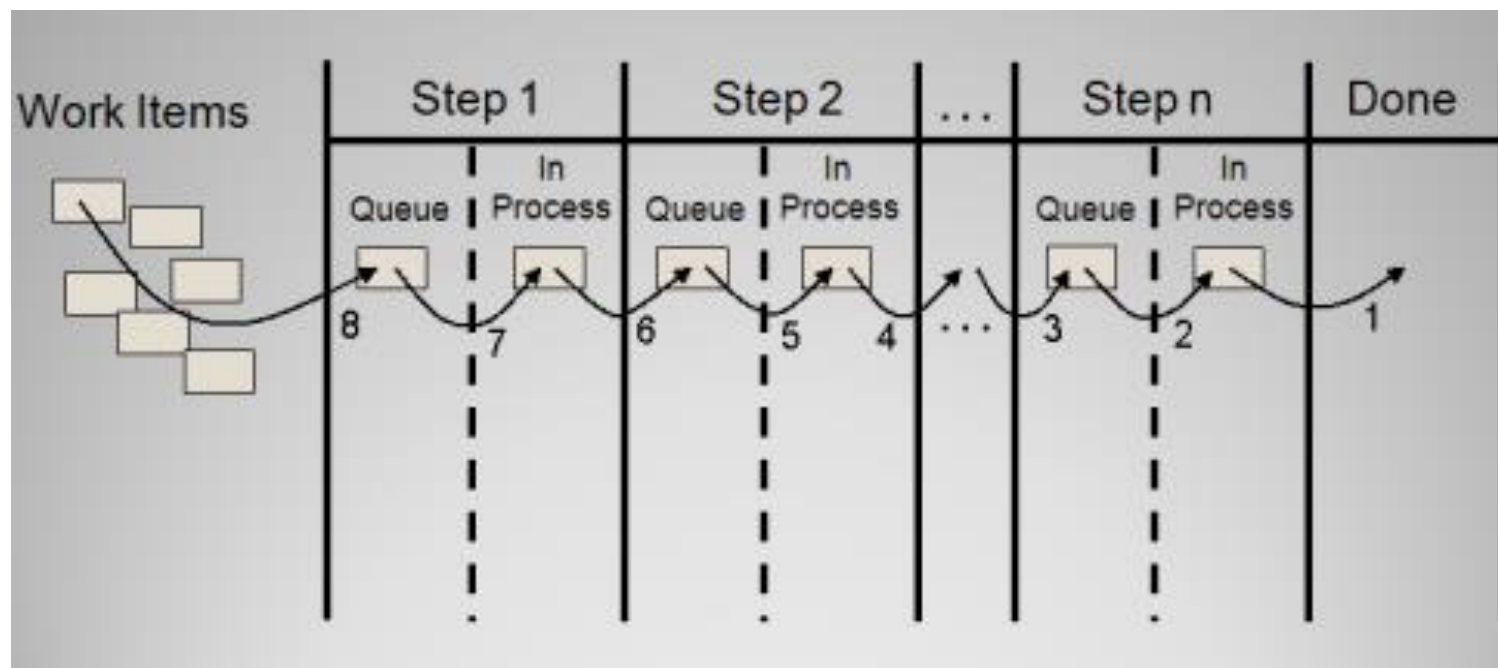

- Erfunden in Japan von Taiichi Ohno von Toyota vor ca. 50 Jahren

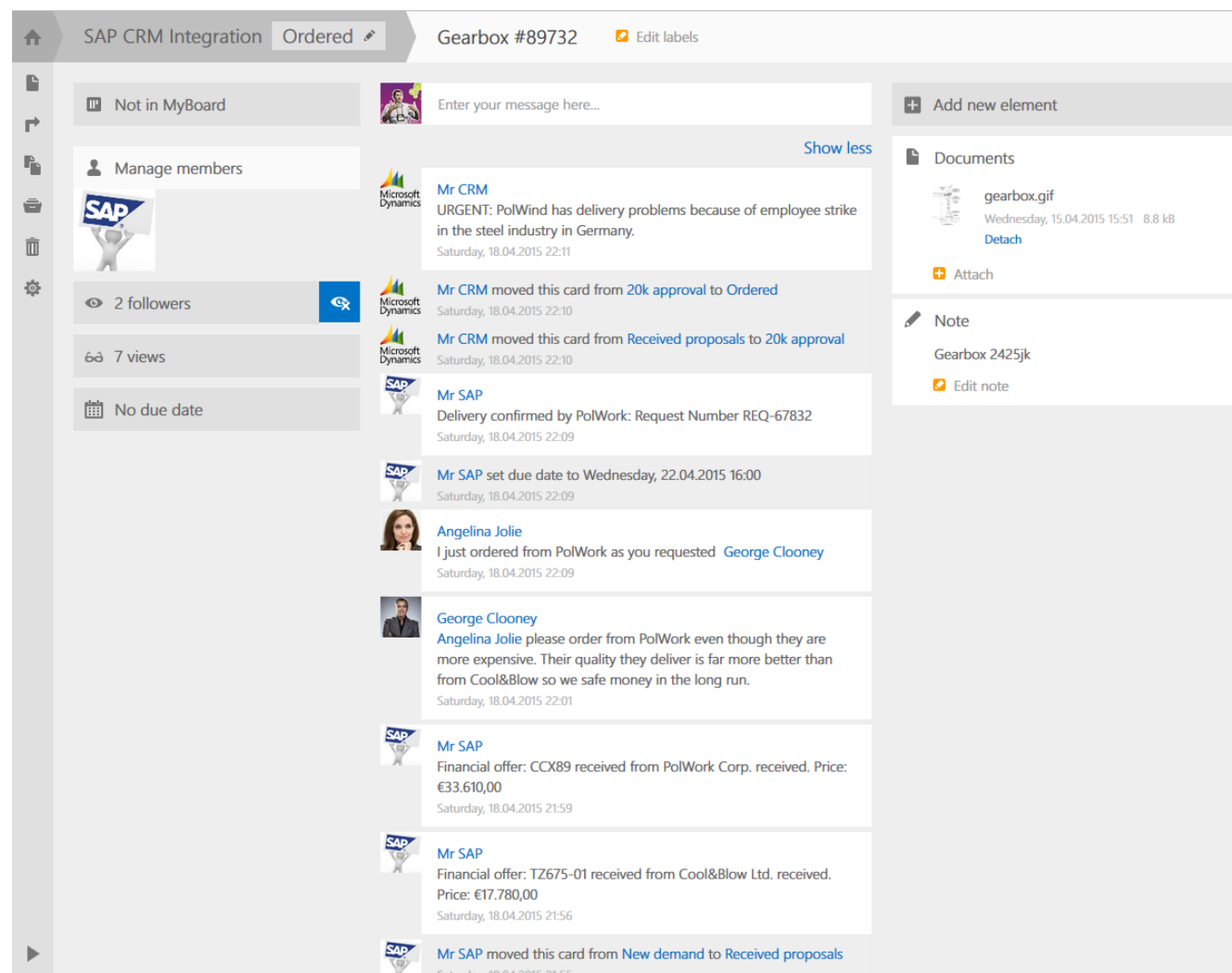


# KanBo – Digitaler Arbeitsplatz
